THE SPORT OF CRICKET HAS A KNOWN HISTORY BEGINNING IN THE LATE 16TH CENTURY. HAVING ORIGINATED IN SOUTH-EAST ENGLAND, IT BECAME THE COUNTRY'S NATIONAL SPORT IN THE 18TH CENTURY AND HAS DEVELOPED GLOBALLY IN THE 19TH AND 20TH CENTURIES. INTERNATIONAL MATCHES HAVE BEEN PLAYED SINCE 1844 AND TEST CRICKET BEGAN, RETROSPECTIVELY RECOGNISED, IN 1877. CRICKET IS THE WORLD'S SECOND MOST POPULAR SPECTATOR SPORT AFTER ASSOCIATION FOOTBALL (SOCCER). GOVERNANCE IS BY THE INTERNATIONAL CRICKET COUNCIL (ICC) WHICH HAS OVER ONE HUNDRED COUNTRIES AND TERRITORIES IN MEMBERSHIP ALTHOUGH ONLY TWELVE CURRENTLY PLAY TEST CRICKET.

3.THE CRICKET MOVEMENT

3.1. TRIGGER MOVEMENT:

TRIGGER MOVEMENT MEANS THAT THE BATSMAN IS IN READY POSITION WITH EITHER WEIGHT ON THE FRONT FOOT AND/OR BACK FOOT. THE TRIGGER IS REPEATABLE BALL AFTER BALL, SO THE BATSMAN IS IN THE RIGHT MENTAL AND PHYSICAL SPACE.

3.2. THE FUNDAMENTAL OF CRICKET

FOR SOME, BATTING IS ARGUABLY THE MOST EXCITING AND IMPORTANT ASPECT OF CRICKET. BOTH FEET SHOULD ALSO BE PARALLEL AND ON EITHER SIDES OF THE BATTING CREASE, AND THE FRONT SHOULDER SHOULD BE DOINTING DOMINIARDS TO THE MICKET, THE BATSMAN SHOULD ALSO HAVE HIS HEAD FACING THE ROWLER

3.3. ORIGIN AND DEVELOPMENT:

CRICKET IS BELIEVED TO HAVE BEGUN POSSIBLY AS EARLY AS THE 13TH CENTURY AS A GAME IN WHICH COUNTRY BOYS BOWLED AT A TREE STUMP OR AT THE HURDLE GATE INTO A SHEEP PEN. THIS GATE CONSISTED OF TWO UPRIGHTS AND A CROSSBAR RESTING ON THE SLOTTED TOPS; THE CROSSBAR WAS CALLED A BAIL AND THE ENTIRE GATE A WICKET. THE FACT THAT THE BAIL COULD BE DISLODGED WHEN THE WICKET WAS STRUCK MADE THIS PREFERABLE TO THE STUMP, WHICH NAME WAS LATER APPLIED TO THE HURDLE UPRIGHTS. EARLY MANUSCRIPTS DIFFER ABOUT THE SIZE OF THE WICKET, WHICH ACQUIRED A THIRD STUMP IN THE 1770S, BUT BY 1706 THE PITCH—THE AREA BETWEEN THE WICKETS—WAS 22 YARDS LONG.

BRITISH KING:

THE ENGLAND CRICKET TEAM REPRESENTS ENGLAND AND WALES IN INTERNATIONAL CRICKET. SINCE 1997, IT BY KING GEORGE V, THE FIRST TIME A REIGNING MONARCH HAD WATCHED TEST CRICKET.

AFTER BEING KNIGHTED, THE PERSON CAN PUT 'SIR' IN FRONT OF HIS NAME INSTEAD OF 'MR.' THERE IS A LARGE LIST OF BRITISH AND NON-BRITISH CRICKETERS WHO

HAVE BEEN RECOGNISED FOR THEIR INCREDIBLE SERVICES TO THE GAME AND WERE ADJUDGED SIMULTANEOUSLY WITH KNIGHTHOOD TITLE.

THE FIRST MAN TO RECEIVE A KNIGHTHOOD FOR SERVICES TO CRICKET, OR INDEED ANY SPORT, WAS FRANCIS LACEY. KNIGHTED IN 1926, LACEY WAS MOST NOTED FOR HIS WORK AS SECRETARY OF MARYLEBONE CRICKET CLUB (MCC), A POST WHICH HE HELD FROM 1898 TO THE YEAR OF HIS KNIGHTHOOD.

THE LATEST CRICKETER TO RECEIVE A KNIGHTHOOD FOR SERVICES TO THE GAME WAS ALASTAIR COOK. THE FIFTH HIGHEST TEST RUN SCORER OF ALL TIME WAS KNIGHTED IN 2019.





THE DESCRIPTION "BIBLE OF CRICKET" WAS FIRST USED IN THE 1930S BY ALEC WAUGH. IN OCTOBER 2013, AN ALL-TIME TEST WORLD XI WAS ANNOUNCED TO MARK THE 150TH ANNIVERSARY OF WISDEN CRICKETERS' ALMANACK.

FIRST EXPERIMENT MATCH: (COUNTY CRICKET)

INTER-COUNTY CRICKET WAS POPULAR THROUGHOUT THE 18TH CENTURY, ALTHOUGH THE BEST TEAMS, SUCH AS KENT IN THE 1740S OR HAMPSHIRE IN THE DAYS OF THE FAMOUS HAMBLEDON CLUB, WERE USUALLY ACKNOWLEDGED AS SUCH BY BEING MATCHED AGAINST ALL-ENGLAND.

THE FIRST COUNTY CRICKET MATCH WAS PLAYED 130 YEARS AGO AT BRISTOL. YORKSHIRE TRIUMPHED OVER GLOUCESTERSHIRE BY 8 WICKETS. THERE WE UNOFFICIAL FORMATS FOR COMPETITION PRIOR TO 1890 BUT THE FIRST OFFICIAL LEAGUE HAD 8 COUNTIES PARTICIPATING.





THE FIRST CRICKET TOUR:

IN 1868, A CRICKET TEAM COMPOSED OF ABORIGINAL AUSTRALIANS TOURED ENGLAND BETWEEN MAY AND OCTOBER OF THAT YEAR, THUS BECOMING THE FIRST ORGANISED GROUP OF AUSTRALIAN SPORTSPEOPLE TO TRAVEL OVERSEAS. IT WOULD BE ANOTHER TEN YEARS BEFORE AN AUSTRALIAN CRICKET TEAM CLASSED AS REPRESENTATIVE WOULD LEAVE THE COUNTRY.

4.THE CRICKET METHOD

CRICKET TECHNIQUE REFERS TO THE BATTING PLAYER'S STANCE BEFORE THE BALL IS BOWLED AS WELL AS
THE MOVEMENT OF THE HANDS, FEET, HEAD, AND BODY IN THE EXECUTION OF A CRICKET STROKE.

WHEN ODI CRICKET WAS FIRST PLAYED, AVERAGE RUN RATE (ARR) WAS USED TO
CALCULATE TARGETS. HERE, THE CHASING SIDE SIMPLY HAD TO MATCH THE OPPONENT'S RUN-RATE. FOR
EXAMPLE, IF TEAM A SCORED 200 IN 50 OVERS, AT A RUN-RATE OF 4, AND IF TEAM B'S INNINGS WAS REDUCED
TO 30 OVERS, THEN THE TOTAL TO OVERCOME WOULD BE 120





4.1. CRICKET IS PHYSICAL ORIENTED HEALTHY SYSTEM:



4.2. CRICKET IS PSYCHOLOGICAL ORIENTED EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM:

THE MENTAL SIDE OF CRICKET IS WHAT SEPARATES THE BEST PLAYERS FROM THE REST. TECHNICAL, TACTICAL, AND PHYSICAL PREPARATION ARE IMPORTANT FOR TOP CLASS PERFORMANCES BUT IT IS OFTEN WHAT HAPPENS INSIDE A PLAYER'S MIND THAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN SUCCESS AND FAILURE. THE VERY BEST PLAYERS AND TEAMS ARE CONFIDENT, MOTIVATED, CONCENTRATE EFFECTIVELY, COPE WITH PRESSURE, AND CONTROL THEIR EMOTIONS.


4.3. PRINCIPLES OF THE METHOD

THE DUCKWORTH-LEWIS-STERN METHOD (DLS) IS A MATHEMATICAL FORMULATION DESIGNED TO CALCULATE THE TARGET SCORE FOR THE TEAM BATTING SECOND IN A LIMITED OVERS CRICKET MATCH INTERRUPTED BY WEATHER OR OTHER CIRCUMSTANCES.



THE CRICKET LAWS:

THE LAWS OF CRICKET IS A CODE WHICH SPECIFIES THE RULES OF THE GAME
OF CRICKET WORLDWIDE. THE EARLIEST KNOWN CODE WAS DRAFTED IN 1744 AND, SINCE 1788, IT HAS BEEN
OWNED AND MAINTAINED BY ITS CUSTODIAN, THE MARYLEBONE CRICKET CLUB (MCC) IN LONDON. THERE ARE
CURRENTLY 42 LAWS (ALWAYS WRITTEN WITH A CAPITAL "L") WHICH OUTLINE ALL ASPECTS OF HOW THE GAME
IS TO BE PLAYED. MCC HAS RE-CODED THE LAWS SIX TIMES, THE SEVENTH AND LATEST CODE BEING RELEASED IN
DCTOBER 2017. THE 2^{NO} EDITION OF THE 2017 CODE CAME INTO FORCE ON 1 APRIL 2019. THE FIRST SIX CODES
PRIOR TO 2017 WERE ALL SUBJECT TO INTERIM REVISIONS AND SO EXIST IN MORE THAN ONE VERSION.

THE ICC CRICKET CODE OF CONDUCT IS A REGULATION REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF PROFESSIONAL PLAYERS IN THE SPORT OF CRICKET, TRADITIONALLY, CRICKET REQUIRES "GENTLEMANLY" CONDUCT FROM ALL PLAYERS. THE CODE OF CONDUCT IS WRITTEN AND ENFORCED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CRICKET COUNCIL.

UNDER THE ICC REGULATIONS, PLAYERS MAY BE FINED A PERCENTAGE OF THE SALARY, BANNED FOR NUMBER OF MATCHES, OR EVEN BANNED FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS OR LIFE. THE ICC APPOINTS A MATCH REFEREE FOR EACH TEST MATCH, ONE DAY INTERNATIONAL AND TWENTY20.

TEST MATCH: ASHES

THE ASHES IS A TEST CRICKET SERIES PLAYED BETWEEN ENGLAND AND AUSTRALIA. THE TERM ORIGINATED IN A SATIRICAL OBITUARY PUBLISHED IN A BRITISH NEWSPAPER, THE SPORTING TIMES, IMMEDIATELY AFTER AUSTRALIA'S 1882 VICTORY AT THE OVAL, ITS FIRST TEST WIN ON ENGLISH SOIL. THE OBITUARY STATED THAT ENGLISH CRICKET HAD DIED, AND "THE BODY WILL BE CREMATED AND THE ASHES TAKEN TO AUSTRALIA". THE MYTHICAL ASHES IMMEDIATELY BECAME ASSOCIATED WITH THE 1882-83 SERIES PLAYED IN AUSTRALIA, BEFORE WHICH THE ENGLISH CAPTAIN IVO BLIGH HAD VOWED TO "REGAIN THOSE ASHES". THE ENGLISH MEDIA THEREFORE DUBBED THE TOUR THE QUEST TO REGAIN THE ASHES.

FATHER OF INDIAN CRICKET:

SIR RANJITSINHJI VIBHAJI JADEJA, THE "FATHER OF INDIAN CRICKET" WAS BORN ON 10TH SEPTEMBER 1872. SIR JADEJA WAS THE RULER OF INDIAN PRINCELY STATE OF NAWANAGAR (NOW JAMNAGAR IN GUJRAT) FROM 1907 – 1933 AND WAS NAMED AS MAHARAJ JAM SAHEB.

IN 1896 AS THERE WAS NO INDIAN CRICKET TEAM SIR JADEJA MADE HIS DEBUT WITH ENGLAND AGAINST AUSTRALIA. HE HAD PLAYED HIS FIRST CLASS FOR CAMBRIDGE UNIVERSITY AND HAD ALSO BEEN A PART OF THE SUSSEX CLUB. EARLIER IT WAS QUITE DIFFICULT FOR THE BATSMEN TO PLAY SHOTS ON THE LEG SIDE, SO THEY PREFERRED TO AVOID PLAYING ON THE LEG SIDE. WHILE AT THE SAME TIME SIR RANJIT JADEJA INVENTED SHOTS LIKE LEG GLANCE AND LATE CUTS. THESE SHOTS ARE CONSIDERED AS THE MOST BEAUTIFUL SHOTS IN CRICKET.

MAHARAJA RANJIT SINHJI IS REFERRED TO AS THE FATHER OF INDIAN CRICKET BECAUSE OF HIS EARLY EXPLOITS IN THE HISTORY OF THE GAME INVOLVING THE BRITISH, AS ALSO FOR HIS STEADFAST PATRONAGE OF THE GAME OF CRICKET IN OUR COUNTRY.

MAHARAJA RANJIT SINHJI WAS A NOTED TEST CRICKET PLAYER WHO PLAYED FOR THE ENGLISH CRICKET TEAM. HE ALSO PLAYED FIRST CLASS CRICKET FOR CAMBRIDGE UNIVERSITY AND COUNTY CRICKET FOR SUSSEX.

IN THE YEAR 1904, HE RETURNED BACK TO INDIA AND STARTED WORKING FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF HIS STATE AND INDIAN CRICKET. ON APRIL 2, 1933, SIR RANJITSINHJI VIBHAJI JADEJA ONE OF INDIA'S GREATEST CRICKETER TOOK HIS LAST BREATH AND FURTHER IN THE YEAR 1934 GIVING A TRIBUTE TO HIM RANJI TROPHY WAS STARTED.

RANJI TROPHY:

THE RANJI TROPHY IS A DOMESTIC <u>FIRST-CLASS CRICKET</u> CHAMPIONSHIP PLAYED IN <u>INDIA</u> BETWEEN MULTIPLE TEAMS REPRESENTING REGIONAL AND STATE CRICKET ASSOCIATIONS. THE COMPETITION CURRENTLY CONSISTS OF 38 TEAMS, WITH ALL 28 <u>STATES IN INDIA</u> AND FOUR OF THE EIGHT UNION TERRITORIES HAVING AT LEAST ONE REPRESENTATION.

THE COMPETITION IS NAMED AFTER THE FIRST INDIAN CRICKETER WHO PLAYED INTERNATIONAL CRICKET, RANJITSINHJI, WHO WAS ALSO KNOWN AS "RANJI".

STATE TEAMS AND CRICKET ASSOCIATIONS AND CLUBS WITH FIRST-CLASS
STATUS ARE QUALIFIED TO PLAY IN THE RANJI TROPHY. WHILE MOST ASSOCIATIONS ARE REGIONAL, LIKE
THE KARNATAKA STATE CRICKET ASSOCIATION AND MUMBAI CRICKET ASSOCIATION, TWO, RAILWAYS AND
SERVICES, ARE PAN-INDIAN

THE COMPETITION WAS LAUNCHED FOLLOWING A MEETING IN JULY 1934, WITH THE FIRST FIXTURES TAKING PLACE IN 1934–35. THE TROPHY WAS DONATED BY BHUPINDER SINGH, THE MAHARAJA OF PATIALA. THE FIRST MATCH OF THE COMPETITION WAS HELD ON 4 NOVEMBER 1934 BETWEEN MADRAS AND MYSORE AT THE CHEPAUK GROUND IN MADRAS. MUMBAI (BOMBAY) HAVE WON THE TOURNAMENT THE MOST TIMES WITH 41 WINS INCLUDING 15 BACK-TO-BACK WINS FROM 1958–59 TO 1972–73.

THE 2020-21 RANJI TROPHY TOURNAMENT WAS CANCELLED DUE TO THE COVID-19
PANDEMIC, THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE TOURNAMENT'S INCEPTION IN THE 1934-35 SEASON THAT THE RANJI
TROPHY WAS NOT HELD, INSTEAD, THE BCCI HAS DECIDED TO ORGANIZE 50 OVERS VIJAY HAZARE TROPHY.

A ONE DAY INTERNATIONAL (ODI) IS A FORM OF LIMITED OVERS CRICKET, PLAYED BETWEEN TWO TEAMS WITH INTERNATIONAL STATUS, IN WHICH EACH TEAM FACES A FIXED NUMBER OF <u>OVERS</u>, CURRENTLY 50, WITH THE GAME LASTING UP TO 8 HOURS. [1][2] THE <u>CRICKET WORLD CUP</u>, GENERALLY HELD EVERY FOUR YEARS, IS PLAYED IN THIS FORMAT. ONE DAY INTERNATIONAL MATCHES ARE ALSO CALLED LIMITED OVERS INTERNATIONALS (LOI), ALTHOUGH THIS GENERIC TERM MAY ALSO REFER TO <u>TWENTY20</u> INTERNATIONAL MATCHES. THEY ARE MAJOR MATCHES AND CONSIDERED THE HIGHEST STANDARD OF <u>LIST</u> A, LIMITED-OVERS COMPETITION.

THE INTERNATIONAL ONE DAY GAME IS A LATE-TWENTIETH-CENTURY DEVELOPMENT. THE FIRST ODI WAS PLAYED ON 5 JANUARY 1971 BETWEEN AUSTRALIA AND ENGLAND AT THE MELBOURNE CRICKET GROUND. WHEN THE FIRST THREE DAYS OF THE THIRD TEST WERE WASHED OUT OFFICIALS DECIDED TO ABANDON THE MATCH AND, INSTEAD, PLAY A ONE-OFF ONE DAY GAME CONSISTING OF 40 EIGHT-BALL OVERS PER SIDE. AUSTRALIA WON THE GAME BY 5 WICKETS. ODIS WERE PLAYED IN WHITE-COLORED KITS WITH A RED-COLORED BALL. [5]

IN THE LATE 1970S, KERRY PACKER ESTABLISHED THE RIVAL WORLD SERIES CRICKET COMPETITION, AND IT INTRODUCED MANY OF THE FEATURES OF ONE DAY INTERNATIONAL CRICKET THAT ARE NOW COMMONPLACE, INCLUDING COLORED UNIFORMS, MATCHES PLAYED AT NIGHT UNDER FLOODLIGHTS WITH A WHITE BALL AND DARK SIGHT SCREENS, AND, FOR TELEVISION BROADCASTS, MULTIPLE CAMERA ANGLES, EFFECTS MICROPHONES TO CAPTURE SOUNDS FROM THE PLAYERS ON THE PITCH, AND ON-SCREEN GRAPHICS. THE FIRST OF THE MATCHES WITH COLOURED UNIFORMS WAS THE WSC AUSTRALIANS IN WATTLE GOLD VERSUS WSC WEST INDIANS IN CORAL PINK, PLAYED AT VEL PARK IN MELBOURNE ON 17 JANUARY 1979.








