1.7 Resident & Non Migrants Birds

Bird migration is the regular seasonal movement, often north and south along a flyway, between breeding and wintering grounds. As some birds may be known to be migratory, there are also those that remain in the same areas throughout the year. These are known as residents or non-migratory birds. Eg Striated Heron. The striated heron (*Butorides striata*) also known as mangrove heron, little heron or green-backed heron, is a small heron, about 44 cm tall. Striated herons are mostly non-migratory.
