Mooning noises made by a group of male birds attract the unpaired females, who then walk past the group and after further calling and head up posturing the number of males gradually reduces to just one in the train. With this the pairing process is evidently complete. The pair proceeds to perform display, and later join part of colony known as laying group. But this pairing only persists for a single breeding attempt, and both birds acquire new partners a few months later.
