

4. Extreme Abilities

Little Weaver (*Ploceus luteolus*)

Ability - Communal Nests for up to 500 pairs of birds.

They nest in colonies as small as ten individuals and up to 400-500 birds.

Their nests are instantly recognizable, massive and resembling huge apartment blocks.

The nest structures can reach heights of up to 4 meter.

4.10 Biggest Communal Nest EXTREME BIRDS Geographical Distribution – Savanna woodland

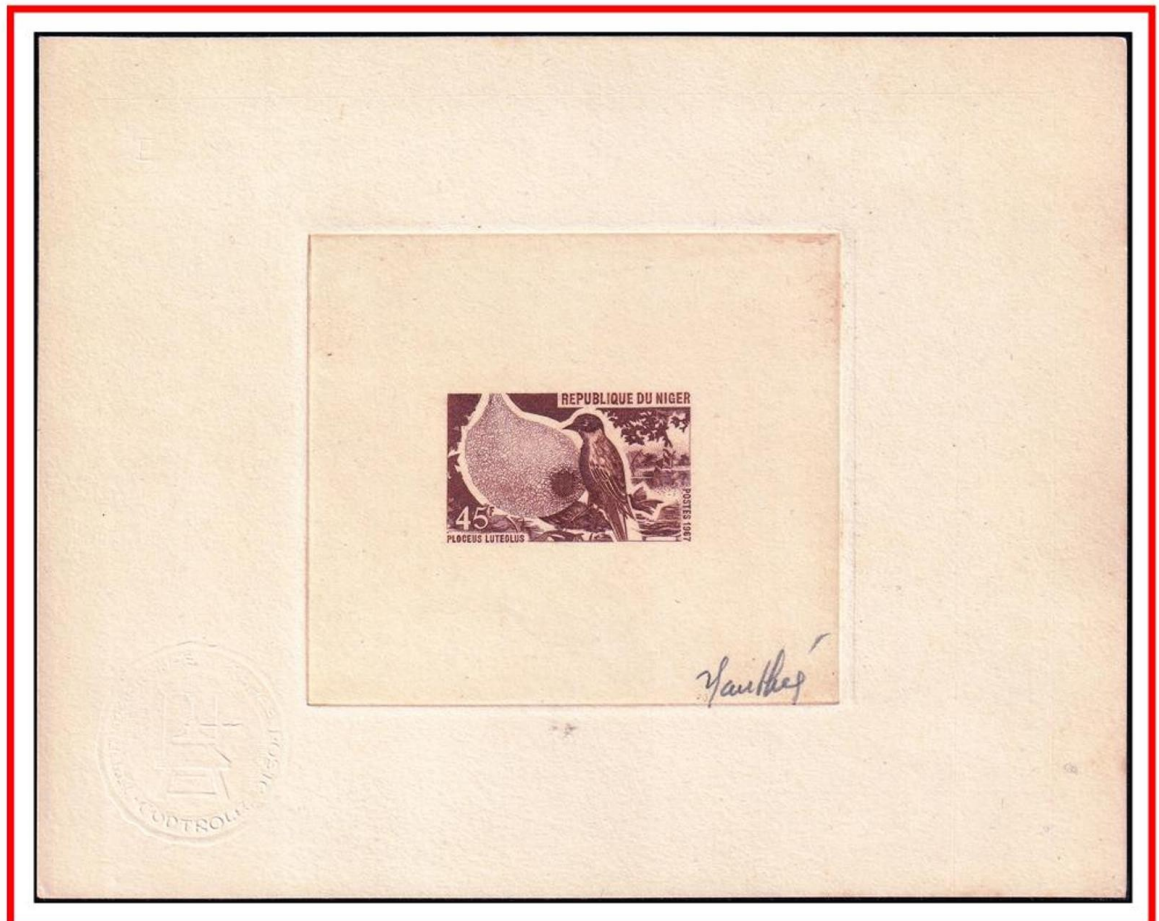


A mere 20mm downpour, may trigger the entire colony into breeding mode, and breeding pairs may be able to churn out up to four broods (4-5 chicks each), attracting even totally unrelated "helpers" to ensure that enough food is found for the last broods.

Photographic evidence has proven that some of these nest structures are over 100 years old.

An artist's proof is, at least in theory, an impression of a print taken in the print making process to see the current printing state of a plate while the plate (or stone, or woodblock) is being worked on by the artist.

Artist's proofs are not included in the count of a limited edition, and sometimes the number of artist's proofs, which belong to the artist, can be twenty or more. By convention, the artist is not supposed to sell these at once.
