5.9 Best Drummer Geographical Distribution – Forests of Americas, Africa, Asia

For the bird is the percussionist of the avian world, the only species to fashion a musical instrument and make a sound with it. The point of the performance is to impress a female. Empty, hollow vertical trunk of dead eucalyptus tree works as sounding board against which the bird will play the beat. They use a small stick, devoid of leaves, to beat the drum. This performance is unique in the bird world. Woodpeckers and other birds use their bills to tap, or their feathers to make vibrating noises in the wind.

The magnificent wispy crest of the Palm cockatoo gives the bird its distinctive look of a drummer in a rock band.


