12.1) RED ARROWS

The Royal Air Force (RAF) Red Arrows are one of the premier aerobatic teams in the world.



The Red Arrows fly the Hawk T1 at speeds in excess of 600mph and the nine display pilots, including the team leader undergo extensive training and practise. Based at RAF Scampton they have been displaying since 1965.

12.2) SNOWBIRDS

The Canadian Forces Snowbirds (431 Air Demonstration Squadron) are the aerobatics flight demonstration team of the Royal Canadian Air Force. The CT-114 Tutor is primarily flown by the Snowbirds.
