

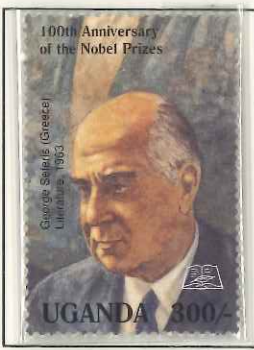

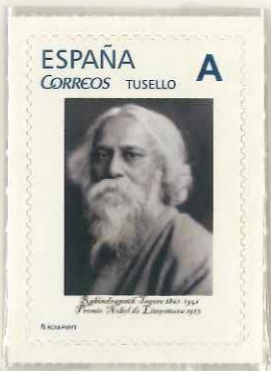


**Pablo Neruda(1971):**"for a poetry that with the action of an elemental force brings alive a continent's destiny and dreams."

**George Seferis(1963):**"for his eminent lyrical writing, inspired by a deep feeling for the Hellenic world of culture."



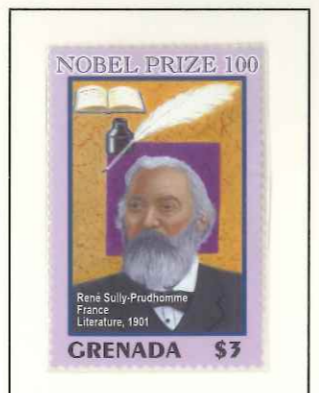
