JAGADISH CHANDRA BOSE (30.11.1858-23.11.1937) A famous scientist wrote Nirudeshar Kahini which was one of the first works of Bengali Science fiction. Also wrote 11 books(31.11.1958).



DADABHAI NAOROJI (4.9.1825-30.6.1917) Wrote at least 9 books(4.9.1968).



ANNIE BESANT (1.10.1847-20.9.1933) A prominent British socialist, theosophist, writer and supporter of self-rule. She wrote at least 23 books(1.10.1963).



C. ACHYUTHA MENON (3.1.1913-16.8.1991) A talented writer and translator (13.1.2013).



TIPU SULTAN (b.20.11.1750)An author, knew many languages and started first news paper Fauji Akhbar (15.7.1974).



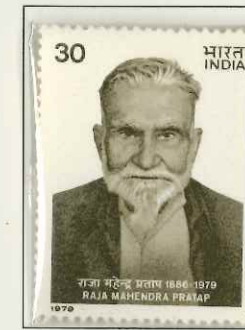
DR. BHAGWANDAS (12.1.1869-18.9.1958) (Bharat Ratna) Wrote at least 30 books (12.1.1969).



K.M. MUNSHI (30.12.1887-8.2.1971) Wrote over 125 books in English, Hindi & in Gujarati (30.12.1888).



SURENDRANATH BANERJEE (10.11.1848-6.8.1925)A great journalist & wrote book 'A Nation in Making' (28.12.1983).



RAJA MAHENDRA PRATAP (1.12.1886-29.4.1979) A nationalist & a prolific writer and a journalist (15.8.1979).



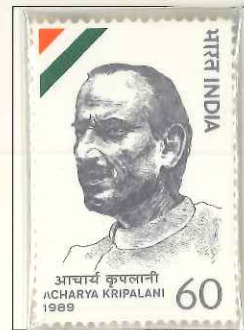

J.B. KRIPLANI (11.11.1888-19.3.1982) Wrote a few books on Gandhian philosophy (11.11.1989).



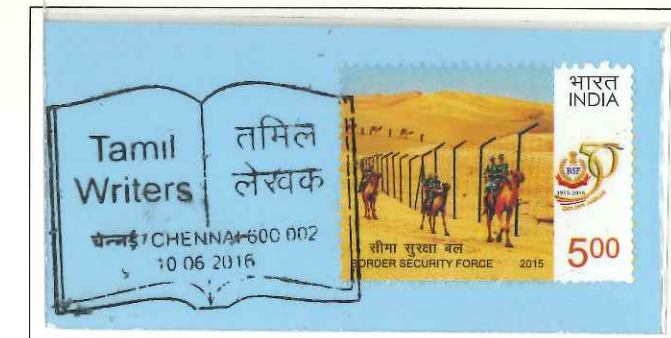
VV GIRI (10.8.1894-23.6.1980) A prolific writer and a Bharat Ratna (24.8.1974).
