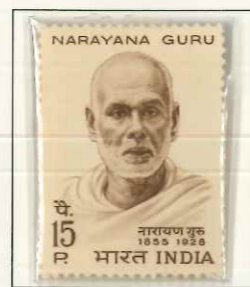


SOCIAL REFORM-AT THE CORE OF WRITING



RAJA RAMMOHAN ROY
(22.5.1772-27.9.1833)
First diamond shaped stamp. A scholar, wrote two memorials, best known for his efforts to abolish Sati (27.9.1964).



NARAYANA GURU
(1854-1928)
Wrote 36 books & taught that all religions are good if they make man better (21.8.1967)



VEMANA (BORN 17th CENTURY)
Telugu philosopher, poet, a great social reformer (16.10.1972).



SAVITRIBAI PHULE
(30.1.1831-10.3.1897)
Wrote books & worked for women's rights during British Rule (10.3.1998).



KANDUKURI VEERESALINGAM
(16.4.1848-27.5.1919)
Wrote 100 books, mostly on social evils (15.7.1974).



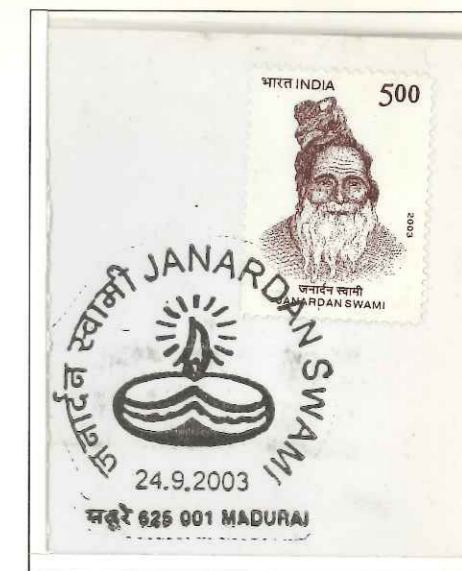
JYOTHI RAO PHOLAY
Wrote 'Shivajicha Powdda' & 16 books; a pioneer of women's education in India (28.11.1977).



GANESH VASUDEV MAVALANKAR
(27.10.1888-27.2.1956)
A Parliamentarian, social worker, educationist & writer as well (27.2.1981).



T RAMASWAMY CHOWDARY
(15.1.1887-16.1.1943) Known as Kaviraju, carried reform through his writings (25.4.1987).



JANARDHAN SWAMI Wrote Nitya niyah vidhi & contributed to society development (24.9.2003).



DR. B R AMBEDKAR
(14.4.1891-6.12.1956)
A Bharatratna, Jurist, Writer & Reformer (14.4.1991).



C.N. ANNADURAI
(1909-1969) Wrote plays, film stories, dialogues, all aimed at social reforms (3.2.1970).



GORA (1902-1985)
A social reformer, an atheist, social reformer (12.8.2002).



GURAJADA VENKATA APPARAO All writings of Gurajada aimed at social reform (21.9.2013).
