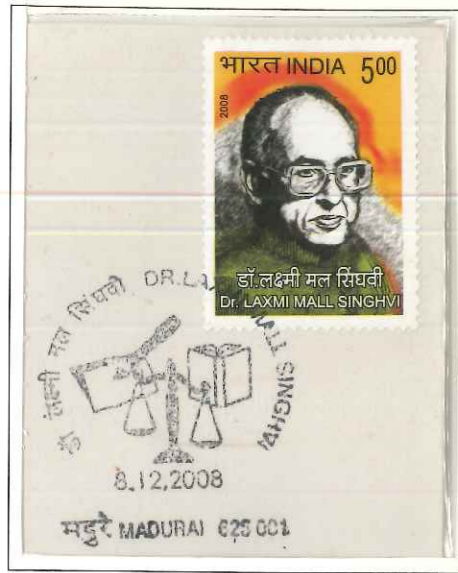

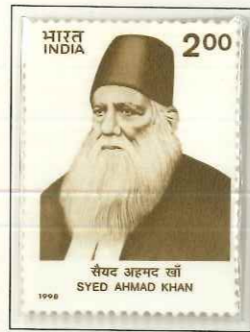
L.M. SINGHVI (9.11.1931-6.10.2007) A jurist, scholar, wrote several books(8.2.2008).



DR. U.V. SWAMINATHA IYER (1855-1942) A Tamil scholar who wrote over 91 books & collected 3067 paper/ palm-leaf manuscripts(18.2.2006).



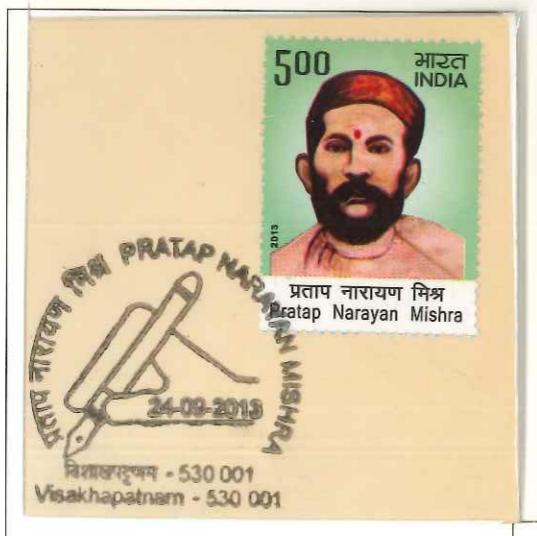
MADHU LIMAYE (1922-1995) Wrote about 40 books in English, 19 in Hindi, 11 in Marathi (1.5.1997).



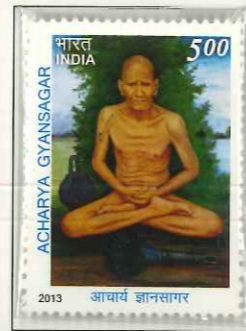
SYED MOHAMMAD ALI SHIHAB THANGAL (4.5.1936-1.8.2009) Islamic scholar (2.8.2010).



VG SURYANARAYANA SASTRIAR (11.8.1870-2.11.1903) A Tamil scholar & prolific writer, wrote novels, prose, essays & poetry. Translated Merchant of Venice into Tamil (17.8.2007).



PRATAP NARAYAN MISHRA (1856-1894) A poet, writer, publisher, play writer and wrote more than 50 books (24.9.2013).



ACHARYA GYANSAGAR A renowned scholar in Sanskrit & wrote 4 Sanskrit epics & 3 Jain Grandhas(10.8.2013)



Ma.Po. SIVAGNANAM (26.6.1906-3.10.1995) Wrote over 100 books, a famous Tamil scholar(15.8.2006).



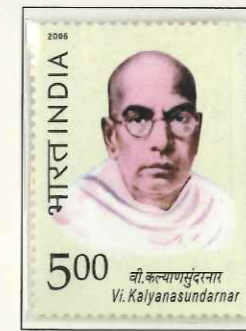
DD KOSAMBI (31.7.1907-29.6.1966) An Indian Mathematician, historian compiled ancient Sanskrit books and wrote many history books



SHEIK THAMBI PAVALAR (1874-1950) Wrote several books, a Sathavadhani & an erudite poet(31.12.2008).



KAE VISHVANATHAM (10.11.1899-19.12.1994) A Tamil scholar & wrote extensively on Siddha medicines(10.11.2010)



KALYANASUNDARNAR (1883-17.9.1953) Wrote over 50 books(21.10.2005).



MAHAVIR PRASAD DWIVEDI (1864-1938) Gave a new style to the Hindi poetry and translated some Sanskrit classics(15.5.1966)



HENRY LOUIS VIVIAN DEROZIO (18.4.1809-26.12.1831) An Anglo-Indian & a first nationalistic poet of modern India, wrote many poems. (15.12.2009).



ACHARYA NARENDRA DEO (1889-1956) wrote 'Abhijnyan Dharmakosa' and other books (19.2.1971 & 6.11.1989).
