Sakhis reflected mysticism and noble thoughts (1.10.1952).




**TULSIDAS (1532-1632)**

**SURDAS (1479-1584)**  
Bhakti tradition, singer, wrote Sur Sagar (1.10.1952).




**RABINDRANATH TAGORE (1861-1941)**  
Wrote more than 3000 works. Nobel Prize-1913 (1.10.1952).

Author of Thirukkural (1.10.1952).



**KALIDAS (5<sup>th</sup> C.AD)**  
Wrote Meghaduta; Abhijnanasakuntalam (22.6.1960).



**MOLLA wrote Ramayana**



**GHALIB (27.12.1797 - 15.2.1869)**wrote 1792 couplets in Urdu and 4340 in Persian (1.10.1952).




**TARIGONDA VENGAMANMBA (1730-1817)** Poetess and devotee of Lord Venkateswara (26.4.2017)



**THYAGARAJA (1767-1847)**Wrote Nanka Charitra & Prahlada Bhakta Vijayamulu (6.1.1961).



**PURANDARADASA (1484-1564)** wrote more than 4,75,000 'Dasara Padagal' and composed Gitas (14.1.1964).



**SWAMI HARIDAS (b.1512)** composed Vishnupadas numbering 128 (19.9.1985).
