


VALMIKI is celebrated as Adi Kavi and wrote epic Ramanyana. Invented sloka (14.10.1970).





SANT NAMDEO (1270-1350)Composed several songs and poems and his songs were incorporated in 'Guru Grandh Sahib' (9.11.1970).




SANT RAVIDAS (15TH C) 41 of his songs were incorporated in 'Guru Grandh Shib' (10.2.1971).

NABAKALEBARA a symbolic recreation of wooden forms of four deities at Jagannath temple based on the Sanskrit manuscripts written on patra-leaves which are kept secretly in the temple(17.7.2015).
