

VALMIKI wrote Ramayana in Sanskrit




MUKTABAI (1279-1297) A saint in Varkari tradition & wrote 41 Abhangas including Tatiughada

JAYADEVA AND GEETA GOVINDA

Sri Geeta govinda is a scripture describing the divine lilas of Sri Radha and Sri Govinda which was written by Sri Jayadeva Goswami who also wrote Chandraleka. In the first section of the famous Geeta Govinda, the poet writes about the ten incarnations (Dasavatar) of Lord Vishnu and he evokes Vishnu as Krishna Kesava. On stamp: This design style was based on Pattachara painting, which is a famous folk art of Odisha. One stamp was on legendary poet Jayadev and rest ten were incarnation of Lord Vishnu known as Dasavatar.
