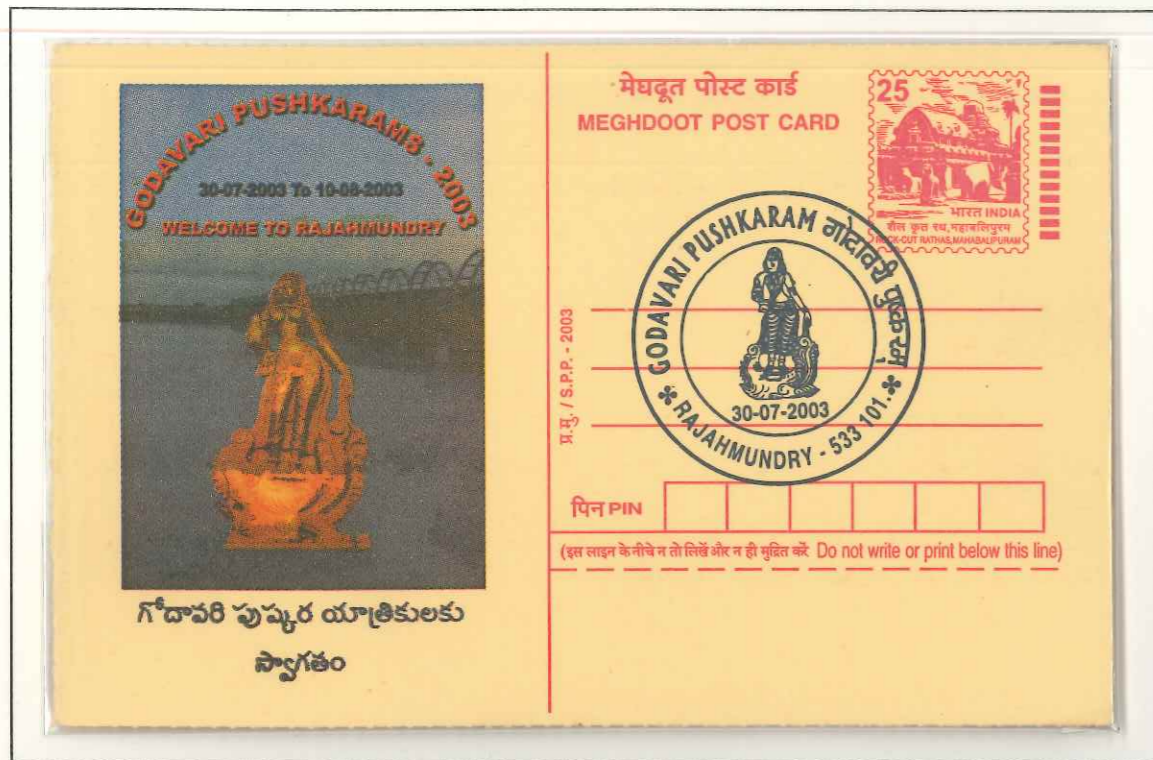


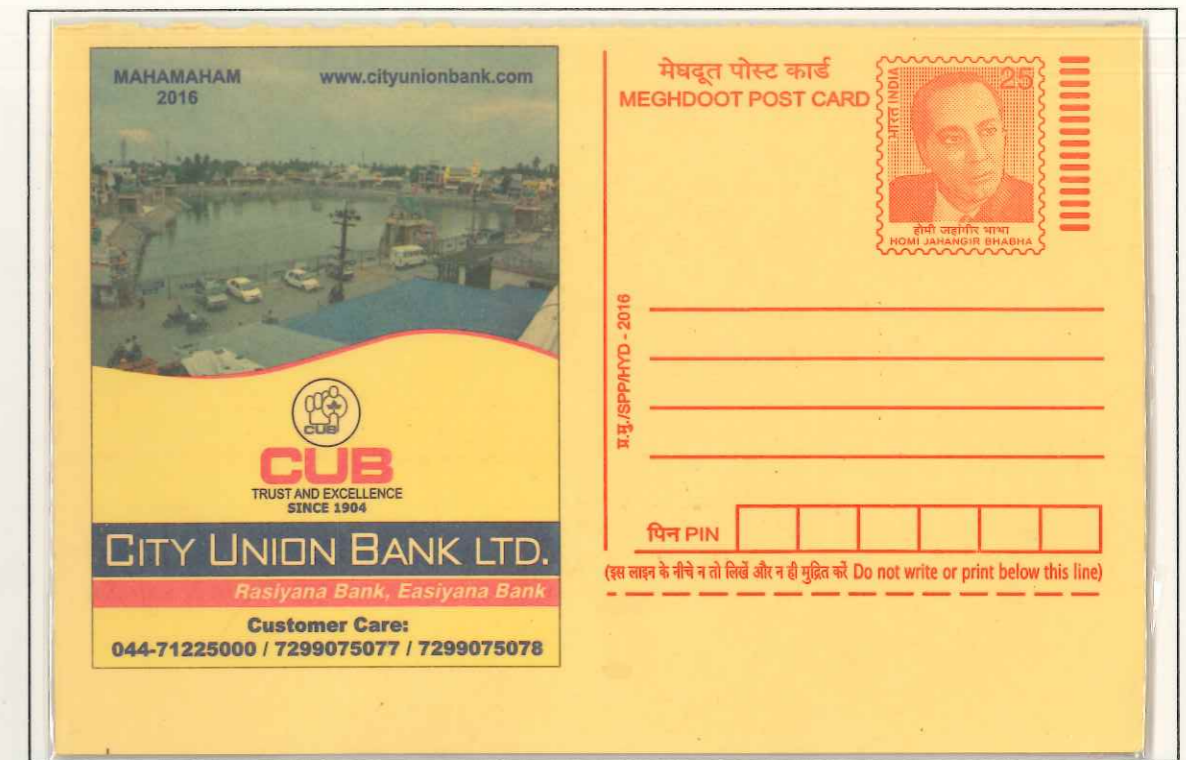
Pushkaram is an Indian festival dedicated to worship rivers. It happens annually for a river and repeated for the same river after 12 years. Each Indian river is associated with a Zodiac sign and the river for each year's festival is based on the sign Jupiter is at the same time.

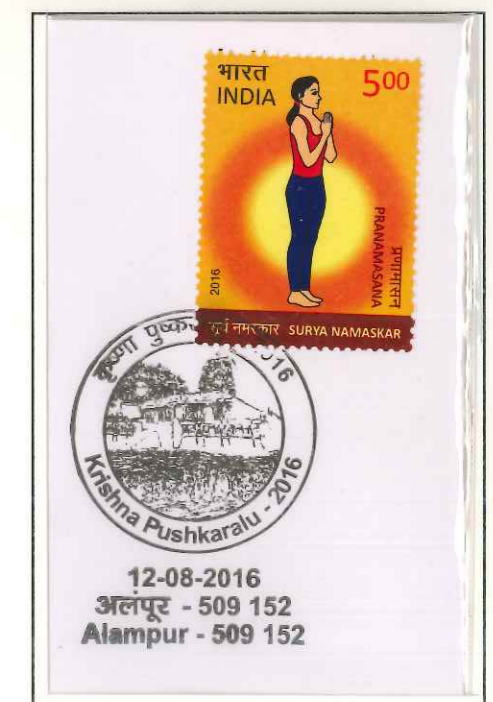
Kooduthurai or Mukkodai is a holy place of confluence of three rivers: Cauvery, Bhavani and Amudha



River Tungabhadra pushkaram: It is believed that Lord Pushkara, popularly known as Lord Varuna, the presiding deity of all rivers will be in river Tungabhadra when Jupiter (Brihaspati) enters Capricorn (Makara rasi) in the Zodiac. Stamp represents Kumbh mela at Prayag where Ganga, Yamuna and Saraswati meet.
